

The Annual Love Checkup

February is a big month in my household. In addition to my wife and her twin's birthday later this month, Valentines day is Mary's favorite holiday, and with two daughters it is a month for me to remind the most precious people in my life that they are loved.

Seems like that is true in the church also. Last night at the Methodist men's gathering they discussed final details for the upcoming Sweetheart Banquet. One question was why do we call it a Sweetheart Banquet? The answer was precious to me. The UMM president answered, "To let the widows and single women of the church know that they


