

The Christmas star led wise astronomers toward Bethlehem to worship the child who would be the promised king. During the days before Christmas, Mary and I watched a Dr. David Jeremiah's special "Why the Nativity?". (I highly recommend it at https://www.davidjeremiah.org/whythenativity) As I watched the story of the Maji, I reflected that all faithful God followers are journeying to be close to the one who was born King of kings, Jesus. The key is to keep following the light.


